About the Event

The Environmental Protection Administration of Taiwan, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the North American Association for Environmental Education (NAAEE) collectively initiated the Global Environmental Education Partnership (GEEP) in 2014. The GEEP aims to promote regional and global environmental education projects with a vision to create a more equitable and sustainable future for all.

To further cultivate the regional connection, the GEEP established the Asia-Pacific Regional Center (APRC) in Taiwan in 2019, for which the Chinese Society for Environmental Education serves as its secretariat. The APRC is under GEEP and is responsible for cooperation and knowledge exchange with governments, industry, academia, and non-governmental organizations in the Asia-Pacific region with the goal to promote environmental education in the region. The APRC will also implement personnel development, integrate educational resources, and develop action plans to address environmental challenges in the Asia-Pacific region and beyond as we form a transnational cooperation network for sustainable development.

The APRC will organize its first international online workshop in September 2021, under the theme **“Let's Learn from Each Other for a Sustainable World.”** The event aims to (1) Facilitate cooperation of environmental education in the Asia-Pacific region, and (2) Amplify the impact and action of the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals through environmental education. Experts from the Asia-Pacific region are invited to share their thoughts with panelists from Taiwan. We welcome environmental experts and professionals in the Asia-Pacific region to join the event.

Dates: Friday, September 3 and Saturday, September 4, 2021

Event Format: The core participants are APRC advisors, along with invited speakers from Taiwan. Case studies and discussions on practical experiences will be included.
